CATTLE HERD HEALTH STATUS DECLARATION AND SIGNED INDEMNITY FORMS MUST BE COMPLETED AND RETURNED WITH THE ENTRY FORM TO THE SHOW SECRETARY NO CATTLE BEFORE 4 PM FRIDAY TO ALLOW FOR DAIRY STOCK TO LEAVE ALL CATTLE TO BE REMOVED FROM THE GROUND BY 4.30 PM SATURDAY ALL PRIZEWINNERS MUST PARADE IN THE GRAND PARADE OR PRIZE MONEY WILL BE FORFEITED

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. All stock to be shown in breed classes to be registered (or eligible) for registration with a recognised Breed Society. Incorrect information could lead to disqualification.
2. All stock to be on the Showground by 8.00 am and remain until after the Grand Parade.
3. A calf which has not turned 8 months by 1st April 2010 may enter with its mother. If 8 months to the day or over, it cannot parade with its mother.
4. **Stall allocation** - Chief Steward must be advised on entry form of an accompanying calf.
5. A heifer to be one that has not had a calf and is under 30 months of age.
6. All stock must be tractable ie. be able to be kept under control as to be considered safe to other exhibitors and spectators. Intractable animals will be removed from the ground at the request of Show Officials, i.e. Stewards/Judges
7. **a) All BULLS from the day they are twelve months of age to have a halter and a nose ring, both with leads attached, when parading, and to be led by responsible handlers. b) Males under 12 months of age & ALL females are to have a halter & nose clip, both with leads attached**
8. Judges decisions on the day will be final & no querying of their decisions will be entered into by the exhibitors. All ribbons will be given at the discretion of the judge. The judge reserves the right not to issue an award.
9. In any protest relative to age, the Judge reserves the right to inspect the mouth of the animal and make the final decision.
10. Exhibitors must supply full particulars on the entry form. **b) Every stud owner MUST enter their own entries on a separate entry form & have the owners signature thereon. Partnership entries have another entry form again with both partners' signatures on it**
11. Entries **MUST** be completed on a Wauchope Show Society entry form & either posted or faxed to the office.
UNDER NO CIRCUMSTANCES WILL PHONE ENTRIES BE ACCEPTED
12. Every animal on the ground **MUST** have a NLIS tag in the offside ear-to be read & recorded at the ground.
13. The tattoo in the ear must match the Registration Form. Stewards reserve the right to check identification and Chief Steward's decision will be final.
ALL EXHIBITORS MUST HAVE A COPY OF EACH ANIMAL'S REGISTRATION PAPERS AVAILABLE FOR INSPECTION BY STEWARDS
14. Sawdust bedding is provided by the Society. Any other bedding is to be provided by the exhibitor.
15. All cattle must be properly secured at all times with both a halter and neck strap, collar or chain. This applies to cattle stalled overnight.
16. **NO** cattle trucks to be parked between the cattle pavilion & judging lawn---bottom flat only
17. Cattle handlers will be dressed appropriately, including solid toed safety shoes or boots
18. The committee reserves to themselves the right of refusing to admit any exhibit on the ground where there is reason to suspect the animal is diseased, unquiet or otherwise unsuitable, and also immediately requiring the removal of any such animal from the exhibition. Stewards may ask for a veterinary inspection if deemed necessary.
19. Chief Steward to be advised of any animals arriving **PRIOR TO SATURDAY, 17TH APRIL 2010**
20. **No** dogs will be allowed in the cattle shed or cattle judging area.
21. Any matter which arises and is not covered by these rules & regulations will be determined by the Chief Steward & the Cattle Committee.

DEFINITIONS

HEIFER: To be one that has not had a calf and is under 30 months of age

TWO BULLS: Can be any 2 bulls, i.e. one older and one younger, both must be bred & owned by the exhibitor. Not to be judged as a pair.

PAIR BULLS: An even pair of bulls i.e. same or similar in size and of similar age.

SIRES' PROGENY GROUP: Three progeny of one sire, both sexes to be represented and any age, must be owned by the exhibitor.

BREEDER'S GROUP: Animals in this group must have been owned and bred by the exhibitor, still owned by the exhibitor, both sexes to be represented and any age.

STUD BEEF CATTLE - Age as at 1.4.2010

CLASSES WILL BE MADE AVAILABLE FOR ANY REGISTERED BEEF BREEDS WHICH ARE NOMINATED.
