Show and Field Days - Compliance with National Livestock Identification System (NLIS)

All cattle moved to a show or field day must be identified with the NLIS device before leaving their property.

Details:

All cattle must be identified with an NLIS device.

A Transport Stock Statement (TSS) must accompany the cattle both on the forward and return journey. A TSS can be either a combined NVD/TSS OR TSS (available from the Kempsey Rural Land Protection office).

Each exhibitor's cattle will be scanned with a portable scanner, it will be necessary for the exhibitor or his/her nominated representative to be on hand at the time of scanning to validate ownership and that the number of cattle scanned is correct.

The tail tag number (PIC) of the property of origin must be made available at the time of scanning.

THE SHOW SOCIETY WILL NOTIFY THE DATABASE OF THE MOVEMENT

REGULATIONS & CONDITIONS

1 **Age of Cattle:** Breeding age of all Dairy animals shall be the age as at 1st January each year.

2 **Exhibitors and Stewards** shall withdraw to a distance from the exhibits, where practicable, while they are being judged.

3 **Any Exhibitor** knowingly making false entries shall forfeit any prizes, which may have been awarded, and the committee shall have power to disqualify any exhibitor for so doing for any period not exceeding two years.

4 **The Committee** reserves to themselves the right of refusing to admit any exhibit on the ground that there is reason to suspect the animal is diseased or otherwise unsuitable, and also of removing any such animal from the exhibition.

5 **Dry Cow** means a cow at least 6 months in calf.

6 **Heifer** means a female, which has not had a calf and is not over 3 years of age.

7 **Animals** competing in progeny must be the property of the Exhibitor.

8 **All prize** animals in the Dairy Cattle Section must take part in the Grand Parade when required, otherwise prize money will be forfeited to the Society.

9 **Electrical Equipment and Power Heads:** Any exhibitors intending to bring electrical equipment to the Showground will be required to ensure that such equipment is fitted with earth leakage circuit breakers and that all electrical leads, tools and appliances have been inspected and tagged by a licensed electrical contractor. This is essential for the safety of yourself, your fellow exhibitors and the general public and is a requirement of the Occupational Health and Safety Act of 1983. The Act imposes very severe penalties in the event of non-compliance with its provisions. Any Exhibitors who do not comply will not be allowed to exhibit at the showground.
